SS-135 White, SS-45 Buttermilk, SS-111 Brightest Yellow, SS-179 Anqique Red, SS-176 Christmas Red, SS254 Golden Ochre, SS-368 Dusty Violet, SS-29 Dew Drop Blue, SS-335 Rich Blue, SS-19 Country Sage, SS-57 Accent Green, SS-211 Orange Rust, SS-339 Terra Cotta, SS-198 Chocolate SS-130 Med. Gray, SS-192 Light Taupe, SS-92 Fuchsia, SS-276 Forest Green, SS-210 Orange, SS-376 Limeburst, SS-24 Chocolate Fudge, SS-234 Medium Mocha and SS-138 Flat Black.

COLOR MIXES: Navy Blue Mix- Start with Rich Blue and add Black in small amounts.

Purple mix- 1:1 Dusty Violet and Rich Blue, adjust as necessary. Dark purple Mix- 3:1 Rich Blue and Christmas Red, Dark Gray Mix-3:1 Med. Gray and Black, Burgundy Mix- 3:1 Antique Red and Chocolate Fudge.

PREPARATION: While casts are damp, slip attach necessary parts and cut out words, stars and place any holes for electrical. Make holes to later insert glittered wire for the crooked web in Ms. Wicked tip of hat and back of spider on her rump. When slip attaching witch to the window on the candle; vent the window where the witch will be attached. Cut out candle windows as desired or shown. Slip attach bat and spiders as desired (it is best if you clean all attached pieces first before attaching to the candles.) Leave cat separate and glue on after decorating. Clean all areas necessary and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Color to areas as follows: **Buttermilk** – White areas. **Light Taupe** - flesh areas. **Terra Cotta** - Orange areas including flames. **Orange** - cats. **Forest Green** - frogs. **Dark Gray Mix** - gray hair. **Country Sage** - green hair. **Burgundy Mix** - red areas. **Chocolate Fudge** - darker brown areas, including skeleton on stir stick and barbed wire hat band. **Med. Mocha** - wooden spoon and recipe. **Lime Burst** - spiders. **Purple Mix** – Triplets base.

Fuchsia – light and dark pink areas.

NOTE: Areas where glitter or embossing powder will be applied need not be antiqued or drybrushed.

ANTIQUÉ: All base-coated areas with Golden Buckskin except where as noted above. Wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Areas with color as follows: **Flesh areas** – Light Taupe 3 to 4 coats, drybrush with blush color of your choice and Light Taupe lightly to all areas of the flesh. With More blush color in your brush, apply to cheeks, noses and chins. **Orange areas-** 3 coats of Orange followed lightly with Buttermilk to highlight. Continue with Buttermilk to tips of ears, paws and tip of tails 3 coats. **Terra Cotta areas-** with 1 coat of Terra Cotta followed with 2 coats of Orange Rust, 3 to 4 coats of Orange and highlight with 3 to 4 coats of Brightest Yellow added to your brush. **Frogs-** 1 coat of Forest Green, followed with 2 coats each of Country Sage, lime burst and highlight with 2 to 3 coats with Brightest Yellow. **Green Hair-** 1 coat Country Sage, followed with 2 to 3 coats Lime Burst highlight with Brightest Yellow. **Buttermilk areas-** 2 coats of Buttermilk, followed with 2 coats white. **Spiders and light Green areas-** 1 coat of Lime Burst, followed with 3 to 4 highlight coats with Brightest Yellow, highlight with White. **Gray Hair-** 1 coat of the gray mix, followed 3 coats of Med. Gray, highlight with Buttermilk 2 to 3 coats. **Fuchsia areas-** 1 coat Fuchsia, followed with 1 highlight coat of White to book and Bath oil bottle, continue bubbles with White until desired color is achieved. **Med. Mocha areas-** 1 coat Med. Mocha, followed with 2 coats Light Umber, highlight with Buttermilk, 2 to 3 coats. **Chocolate Fudge areas-** Re-basecoat areas where needed. Drybrush 1 coat of Chocolate Fudge, followed with 2 coats each of the following, Chocolate, Med. Mocha, Golden Ochre and highlight with Buttermilk. Continue the skull with 3 heavy coats of Buttermilk and then 1 coat of White. **Hat bows-** Paint a coat of **Burgundy mix** to bows. When dry, drybrush with 5 to 6 coats of Christmas Red, continue with 3 coats of Orange. With a fresh brush, drybrush the bows with 1 coat of Christmas Red; this will tone down the orange and give you a beautiful vibrant red.

CANDLE BASE

Drybrush the very top edge of the base very, very lightly with the **dark purple mix**. This will take at least 3 to 4 very light coats.

BASECOAT: All remaining areas with Flat Black.

Drybrush candle's window area including shutters with 2 coats each of the following, Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate and Med. Mocha, continue window frame with 2 coats of Golden Ochre and highlight lightly with Buttermilk. Mottle the bricks with Dusty Violet and Dew Drop Blue, leaving some of the Med. Mocha color showing through. With a fresh brush drybrush **Shutters-** 2 coats each of Terra Cotta and Orange Rust and 4 coats of Orange, highlight with Brightest Yellow. **Purple areas-** 2 to 3 coats of the **dark purple mix**, followed with 2 coats with Buttermilk added to your brush to highlight. Lighten the candle wax and bats with a little more Buttermilk added to your brush, to achieve a lighter purple than the witch's garments.

SHADE: Using Country Sage, shade witch flesh to give her a nice green glow. Using Chocolate Fudge shade wooden spoon and recipe.

RE-BASECOAT IF NEEDED- Any black or red areas that need touching up, with Flat Black or Christmas Red to these areas where glitter will be applied.

FINISH CANDLES, WITCHES AND BASES USING GLITTER AND STICKY BLACK FELT

Apply Gloss Sealer to black areas of the candle, witches hats and pots. Before the sealer dries sprinkle on **Charcoal Embossing powder**. Repeat with sealer to black bases and the candle base as shown, using **extra fine Ebony Glitter**. **Orchid Glitter is used** on the purple base and stars on Ms. Wicked's dress. **Fine Cherry glitter or embossing powder** on red areas. **Extra fine Pumpkin glitter** on the cat's stripes. Cats whiskers with **extra fine Bling glitter**. Apply Matte Spray to all pieces. This will help set the glitter. Apply peel and stick black felt to the bottom edge of the candle to protect the base and block out any light. **SPIDER'S WEB:** Bend a length of copper or similar wire this way and that as shown for spider's web from Ms. Wicked tip of hat to the spider on her rump, using a thick glue or glitter glue coat the wire and apply glitter, allow to dry and attach to hole in hat and spider.

PREPARATION: While cast is damp cut out as shown or desired and place all holes as desired for electrical and lighting. . Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Orange areas- Terra Cotta **Red areas-** **Burgundy Mix**

Antique: Using Golden Buckskin Twinkle

DRYBRUSH: Orange areas- 1 coat of Terra Cotta, 2 coats of Orange Rust and 4 coats Orange. Highlight with 3 to 4 coats of Brightest Yellow to face area only, then lightly with Buttermilk. Blush cheeks and noses lightly with Christmas Red added to your brush. **Red areas-** re-basecoat bows with **Burgundy mix**. Drybrush with 5 to 6 coats of Christmas Red, followed with 3 coats of Orange. With a fresh brush, drybrush 1 coat of Christmas Red. Paint the stems with Flat Black and drybrush with 2 coats each of Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate, Med. Mocha and Golden Ochre. Drybrush the eyes with Buttermilk and White. Paint eyes using Rich Blue for the iris.

SPIDERS AND FROGS

PREPARATION: After removing cast from mold cut out spider light top. When dry clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Spiders- Limeburst, **frogs-**Accent Green, **oops sign** with Terra Cotta and **book pages** with Buttermilk.

ANTIQUÉ: With Buckskin Twinkle

DRYBRUSH: Spiders - 1 to 2 coats of Limeburst, followed with 3 to 4 coats of Brightest

Yellow, highlight with White. **Frogs**- 1 coat Accent Green, followed with 2 coats each of Forest Green, Country Sage, Lime Burst, Brightest Yellow and highlight with White. Book pages with Buttermilk and White. **Oops sign** -1 coat Terra Cotta, followed with 2 coats of Orange Rust, 3 to 4 coats of Orange. Highlight with Brightest Yellow and Buttermilk.

FINISH: Paint hat black, belt Christmas Red and buckle Silver. Apply gloss sealer and apply Charcoal Embossing Power to black area, Cherry fine glitter or embossing powder to red areas and extra fine Bling glitter to buckle. Apply Apple Green Tinsel Glitter to spiders as shown.

TRIPLE STUMP AND STUMP BOX

DRYBRUSH STUMP: With Navy mix followed with Purple mix. Continue bare wood area with Dusty Violet and Royal Fuchsia.

FINISH: Hook up with electrical and solar lighting as desired.

BASECOAT: Chocolate Fudge

DRYBRUSH: 2 heavy coats of Chocolate to the entire piece. Follow with 2 heavy coats each of Med. Mocha, Golden Ochre and Buttermilk to the bare wood only. **Mushrooms**- are Terra Cotta, Orange Rust, Orange, Brightest Yellow and Buttermilk.

SHADE: If desired with Black.

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
