

MAYCO ACRYLIC STAINS USED ON THIS FLYER: SS-135 White, SS-24 Chocolate Fudge, SS-198 Chocolate, SS-237 Dark Brown, SS-234 Medium Mocha, SS-212 Light Umber, SS-45 Buttermilk, SS-210 Orange, SS-176 Christmas Red, SS-57 Accent Green, SS-3 Honey Toast, SS-254 Golden Ocher, SS-111 Brightest Yellow, SS-19 Country Sage, SS-276 Forest Green, SS-179 Antique Red SS-335 Rich Blue SS-376 Limeburst, SS-331 Med. Blue and SS-138 Flat Black

COLOR MIXES USED ON THIS FLYER: **DARK BLUE MIX – START WITH RICH BLUE AND ADD VERY LITTLE BLACK, GREEN MIX- 3:1 Forest Green and Med. Mocha, RED MIX – Start with Antique Red and slowly mix in Chocolate Fudge until you achieve a burgundy red shade.**

MAYCO DIPPING CLEAR GLAZE: S-2000

MAYCO BRUSHES: AB-834 ¾" Basecoat, RB-138 3/8" Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, 10/0 Mini Liner

CB 110, Script Liner CB 106, #4 Soft Fan CB-604, UB and round AB Drybrushes.

HEDGEHOGS AND LOG ROUNDS MOLD NUMBERS

3745 Tasha Hedgehog 10" T x 7.25" W 31 \$90.00

3746 Hedge Hedgehog 6" T x 9.5" W x 11" L 30 \$90.00

3747 2" Tall Garden Log Round 2" T x 9.75" W 15 \$60.00

3748 3" Tall Garden Log Round 3" T x 9.75" W 18 \$70.00

PREPARATION: For use as a shallow planter trim back log rounds pour gate area about ¼ in of the edge. Glaze inside of planter and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Chocolate Fudge

DRYBRUSH: LOG ROUNDS: as follows- heavily on bare wood areas with 2 coats each of Chocolate, Med. Mocha, Light Umber, Golden Ochre and Buttermilk. Apply these same colors everywhere else, except using lighter drybrush coats. Drybrush the fungi, Orange, Honey Toast and highlight with Buttermilk.

GREEN WASH: If desired apply a green wash using a 1:1 mix of Limeburst and Brightest Yellow. Mix this with 1:1 with water. Over a sink with running water apply color to the entire stump and log using a fan brush and adding water to help it flow. Allow to dry undisturbed.

SHADE: Shade bark with Black.

HEDGEHOGS: Basecoat with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: with two heavy coats each of Chocolate and Med. Mocha to entire piece. Drybrush two heavy coats of Golden Ochre to all lighter areas of the hedgehogs and apply a lighter coat to the darker brown areas. (refer to picture) Continue with Buttermilk added to your brush to the lighter areas of the hedgehogs. With a fresh brush using Chocolate, darken upper arms, feet, ears and around the noses and anywhere else where you may have over drybrushed. Add some Light Umber to your brush and blend in the face/eye area, very lightly. With a fresh brush and very little Black, blend around the nose. If needed shade the Hedgehogs with Black.

PAINT: Eyes and noses with Black and use gloss sealer to shine.

IMA BUSY, ANNA BUZZIN, LADY & GENT BUG MOLD NUMBERS

3539 Lady Bug 8.5" T X 5" W \$55.00

PREPARATION: Clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Basecoat yellow flowers and the bees bodies with Honey Toast. Flower stems with Forest Green. Blue flowers with Med. Blue. Bee's wings and white flowers with Buttermilk.

Bug faces and lady and gent bugs bellies with Chocolate Fudge.

APPLY A WASH: Paint on a wash of 3:1 water and Medium Mocha to all color areas except the Chocolate Fudge areas. This wash is painted on without dripping. Allow to dry.

DRYBRUSH: NOTE: Be sure to allow drying in between drybrush coats. It is not a bad idea to use a fan. Drybrush the Chocolate Fudge areas with 2 heavy coats of Chocolate followed with 2 heavy coats of Chocolate, 2 heavy coats of Med. Mocha, 2 lighter coats of Light Umber, 3 lighter coats of Golden Ochre. Highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Blush Cheeks very lightly with blush color of your choice added to your brush. On Lady and Gent's face use a fresh brush, and lightly drybrush Buttermilk onto white cheek area and eye spots as shown. Drybrush **GREEN AREAS** with 2 coats of the following: Forest Green and a mix of Forest Green and Country Sage. Highlight with Limeburst, Brightest Yellow and Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush **BLUE AREAS** with 1 coat of Medium Blue, followed with White added to your brush to highlight. Drybrush **YELLOW AREAS** with Honey Toast and a small amount of Brightest Yellow. Highlight lightly with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush the white areas of the bees with Buttermilk and White.

BASECOAT: Lady and gent bug's shell with the Red Mix. **Drybrush the shells** with 4 coats of Christmas Red, followed with Orange added to your brush to highlight 3 to 4 coats.

PAINT: Carefully and neatly basecoat the bugs flower centers and black areas with Black. Basecoat the bees dark stripes, arms, feet and antenna area with Black.

Drybrush: Flower centers lightly with Chocolate Fudge, followed with Chocolate, Med. Mocha and Golden Ochre. Drybrush black areas on bees with Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate and very lightly with Med. Mocha, add Golden Ochre to your brush and lightly drybrush the stripes.

SHADE: With the dark blue mix all the blue areas. With Med. Mocha all the White areas. With Chocolate Fudge around all faces and the bug's bellies.

3751 GB Two Faced Garden Worm 2.5"T x 3.75"L 6 \$30.00

PREPARATION: Place holes for 12 gauge copper wire and beads for antenna in the large bugs and smaller holes for 16 gauge copper wire in the small bugs. Clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: All pieces with Black

MOSQUITOS and DINOS

Drybrush mosquitos and dinos everywhere with 2 coats each, Dark Brown, Chocolate Fudge and Chocolate. With a fresh brush, drybrush stomach area with 1 coat of Christmas Red. Drybrush body with 4 coats of Orange blending into the red. Follow with a couple coats Brightest Yellow added to your brush, concentrating most of the yellow to the center and higher areas. Highlight lightly with Buttermilk. Blush cheeks with Terra Cotta and a touch of Christmas Red. Drybrush the wings with 2 coats of Country Sage, 2 to 3 coats Limeburst and 2 to 3 coats of Brightest Yellow. Teeth with Buttermilk and White.

GRASSHOPPERS: DRYBRUSH: Heavy with 1 coat of Accent Green and 2 coats of Forest Green, add Country Sage to your brush and apply 2 heavy coats everywhere except the legs. Apply 1 light coat to the legs. Highlight with 1 coat of Sage to the tops of legs. Add Limeburst to your brush and drybrush heavy to stomach and wings, 2 coats. Drybrush the Limeburst lighter to the face with 2 coats and 2 to 3 highlight coats to tops of arms, legs, hands, etc. Add Brightest Yellow to your brush and repeat steps above. Highlight stomach with Buttermilk and lightly to face. (refer to picture.) Drybrush eyes with Buttermilk and White.

PAINT: Paint iris with color of choice.

FINISH: Use 12 gauge copper wire and beads for antenna. Use 16 gauge wire and smaller beads on all the sm. bugs.

PREPARATION: Slip attach desired Gangbuster to plant tender, making a good seal. Cut out a hole in the upper back of the Gangbuster for access to fill with water. It may be necessary to open up pour gates. Either slip attach or later glue Gangbusters to stakes.

COLORS USED ON THE WORMS, OWLS AND PLANT STAKES: Candy Apple Red, Butter Me Up, Cotton Tail, Tuxedo, Honey Dew List and Orange a peel.

Apply one creamy coat of Honey Dew List with a dash of Sour Apple to all pale green areas. Finish with 3 coats of desired color to complete. Decorate as desired. **FOR PLANT TENDERS: Do not glaze the inside or outside of the area of the plant tender that will be submerged in soil.** Glaze the inside only of the Gangbuster attached. Apply one coat of Clear **Glaze to complete.**

Fire to cone 06.

DINOS AND MUSHROOMS: Apply a brown wash such as Camel Back and then wipe off excess.

Paint one water thinned coat of color to each dino, colors used as follows: Blue Dino – Blue Dawn, Orange Dino – Orange a Peel, green Dinosaurs – Honeydew List. 3 coats of desired color to dino’s spine. Dot eyes with Cotton tail, color and then Tuxedo. Toe nails Cotton Tail.

Mushroom stems – apply a quick wash of Old Lace, Mushroom tops apply 2 coats of Tu-Tu Tango. Apply Cotton Tail to spots on mushroom caps. Dip in Clear Dipping.

ASSEMBLY: Use 12 gauge Copper wire and beads for antennae on larger pieces. Use 16 gauge and smaller beads on all the small bugs.
