PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds place all holes for lights and lighting, cut out all windows and doors as desired. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Snowmen - Buttermilk, trunks of trees – Chocolate Fudge, Green

areas of trees and maple looking leaves on snowmen with **Green Mix**. Holly leaves with Accent Green. Mittens and scarves with Med. Blue. Base of cottages with **Blue Snow Mix**. Basecoat windows and doors with various colors, Med. Blue, Antique Red, Honey Toast and Purple mix.

ANTIQUE: With Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Buttermilk areas with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk followed with 1 to 2 coats of White. **DRYBRUSH**: All Chocolate Fudge areas with Chocolate Fudge followed with 2 coats each of Chocolate and Medium Mocha, highlight with Golden Ochre added to your brush. Drybrush green areas with Green Mix followed with 3 coats of Golden Ochre added to your brush, highlight with 2 light coats of Buttermilk. Drybrush holly leaves with Accent Green, Forest Green, Sage and Limeburst. Drybrush windows, doors and snowmen mittens and scarves with the original basecoat color, highlight with White added to your brush. For red windows, drybrush with Christmas Red and add Orange to your brush to brighten.

PAINT: Snowman hats Black and noses Orange. Drybrush snowman noses with Buttermilk added to Orange.

APPLY SNOW AND GLITTER: With a palette knife and non-fired snow, apply snow to snowman hats, trees, holly leaves, berries, edges of windows and doors and to cottage bases (refer to flyer). Before the snow dries, sprinkle on glitter, allow to dry. Glue in large and small globe lights. Apply a small dab of snow to the globe lights and again before it dries, sprinkle with glitter. When completely dry, lightly blow off excess glitter and lightly spray with Mayco's Matte Spray. This will help keep the glitter in place.

DOTTED SWISS SNOWMEN

Use a small pliable squeeze bottle and fill with non fire snow. Cut off tip just enough that the snow can flow through without too much trouble. Dot snowmen in a uniform pattern and before it dries sprinkle with glitter. Allow to dry somewhat. If peaks remain on your snow dots, lightly tap down peak with a gentle finger. Allow to dry completely.

RE ANTIQUE: If your letters in the words on the snowmen need more antique, antique only the word areas. Wipe off with a soft cloth, using paint thinner and a clean cloth; gently remove all of the antique from the surface of the snowmen around the word areas.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds place all holes for lights and lighting, cut out all windows and doors as desired. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Snow areas with the **Blue Snow Mix.** Basecoat the stones on the base and house with Med. Mocha. Trim on chateau with Med. Blue, Honey Toast, Antique Red, **Purple mix and Green mix.**

ANTIQUE: With Golden Buckskin, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Stones with Med. Mocha, followed with the **Stone Mix.** Highlight with Buttermilk in your brush here and there to give varying degrees of color to stone. Drybrush the snow areas of base with **snow mix** and White. Drybrush the Purple, yellow and blue colors with the original basecoat color and add White to your brush to highlight. Add a little purple to the stones here and there. Green areas with the **Green mix**, followed with Golden Ochre and buttermilk. Red areas with Antique Red, followed with Christmas Red and highlight with Orange.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, place all holes and stars as desired for electrical and lighting. To light up the sleigh tree cut a hole for a snap in socket near the top of the sleigh bed and a large hole in the back of the tree, to accommodate the sleigh socket. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Light Taupe – Santa's flesh. Buttermilk – all white areas. Chocolate Fudge – Reindeer body, Santa's mittens and shoes, all tree trunks and brown areas of snowmen's clothes. Antique Red – Red areas of Sleigh. Chocolate – Brown Trim on Santa's coat and hat and blankets. Accent Green – Sleigh Tree and evergreen trees on reindeer blankets, es. Blue Mix – All blue

areas: Snowmen bodies, snow areas, and blue trim on snowmen's clothes. **ANTIQUE:** With Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush Light Taupe to Santa's face, blush cheeks and nose lightly with blush color of your choice. Drybrush Buttermilk areas with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk followed with 1 to 2 coats of White, apply 2 extra drybrush coats to Santa's beard and mustache. Drybrush blue area with Blue Mix. Add White to your brush and continue to drybrush snow and snowmen to desired lightness. Drybrush green trees with Accent Green followed with Forest Green. highlight lightly with Country Sage. Drybrush red areas with 1 coat of Antique Red, followed with 3or 4 coats of Christmas red and highlight with a couple of coats of Orange. DRYBRUSH REINDEER - with 2 coats of Chocolate Fudge, followed with 2 coats of Chocolate and Medium Mocha. Highlight reindeer body with Light Umber. Apply 2 heavier coats to antlers and continue antlers with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush all other Chocolate Fudge areas with Chocolate Fudge followed lightly with Chocolate. Drybrush Chocolate areas with Chocolate. Continue these areas and all lighter brown areas with Medium Mocha. Highlight tree trunks, lighter squares on blankets and Santa's coat and hat trim and brown trim on snowmen lightly with Light Umber followed with Buttermilk. Paint scene snowmen hats and scarves as desired or shown. Drybrush stars with Emperors Gold.

PAINT: Paint eyes, hooves and reindeer nose's and sleigh runners with Black. Paint snowmen noses with Orange, drybrush noses with Orange and Buttermilk mixed.

SHADE: Shade Buttermilk areas using Medium Mocha. Shade snow areas using **Dark Blue Mix.** Glue in lights and apply Mayco's non fired snow as desired.
