MAYCO ACRYLIC STAINS USED ON THIS FLYER: SS-135 White, SS-45 Buttermilk, SS-234 Medium Mocha, SS-210 Orange, SS-92 Royal Fuschia, SS-179 Antique Red, SS-176 Christmas Red, SS-19 Country Sage, SS-111 Brightest Yellow, SS-141 Light Pink, SS-81 Shimmering Silver, SS-03 Honey Toast, SS-376 Limeburst, SS-231 Med. Blue, SS-368 Dusty Violet, SS-335 Rich Blue, SS-192 Light Taupe, SS-24 Chocolate Fudge and SS-138 Flat Black.

COLOR MIXES USED: Dark Purple-2:1:1/2- Rich Blue, Dusty Violet and Christmas Red. DARK BLUE: Start with Rich Blue and add a small amount of Black.

PASTEL COLORS USED: all pastel colors were mixed with a 1:1 ratio of original color and White. Limeburst, Honey Toast, Med. Blue, Fuschia and Dusty Violet.

MAYCO BRUSHES: AB-834 ³/₄"Basecoat, RB-138 3/8"Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, 10/0 Mini Liner

CB 110, Script Liner CB 106, #4 Soft Fan CB-604, UB and round AB Drybrushes

MISC: Stopper sizes by Niagara, 261 for birdhouse, 727 for beetle bug and 193 for cruiser and Ig. retro camper, glitter of choice, ribbon, shoe jewelry, beads and baubles.

PREPARATION: When pouring Droogie's body pour the mold on an angle filling the head and lowering the mold slowly to complete the filling of slip. Be sure the body and head cavities drain when pouring out the slip for both the dragonfly and chameleon.

AIRBRUSH: Ziggy and Droogie were airbrushed. Prepare all the colors for airbrushing before you begin. We prepared 7 airbrush bottles, an airbrush bottle for each color used. Colors used are as follows: Orange, Limeburst, Turquoise, Fuchsia, Brightest Yellow and Christmas Red. Mix for the Purple used is Rich Blue with a small amount of Black and a small amount of Antique Red. Slowly add the small amounts of Black and Antique Red until you achieve the desired color. Airbrush colors to areas as shown or desired. We went from one color to the next color in sequence to blend colors as we went along. That may mean we went back to colors previously used.

PAINT: Ziggy's eyeballs are painted Brightest Yellow, Droogie's are White. Paint swirl to Ziggy's eyes with Orange. Paint Droogie's iris with Turquoise, pupil Black.

SHADE: Seams on Droogie and Ziggy with Chocolate Fudge.

AIRBRUSH: Weld dots on both Droogie and Ziggie with Medium Mocha. Paint each dot with Shimmering Silver. Paint accent flowers or designs to Droogie and Ziggy with Shimmering Silver.

PREPARATION: While cast is still damp cut out windows and door as shown or desired. If using the cars as banks and the Ig. retro camper as a bird house, open pour holes to accommodate stoppers. Place all holes for electrical. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: You can apply separate basecoat colors to all the pieces using the flyer as your guide. For the A-Line trailer, basecoat with a dark gray, no need to apply the wash to this trailer. APPLY WASH: Apply a medium thin wash of Medium Mocha and water 1:3 making sure the wash gets into all crevices. Allow to dry.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush approximately 2 coats per color, apply the first coat on the heavy side allowing some color in the detail, allow drying time in between coats. Drybrush 2 to 3 different areas at one time allowing colors to dry while working on other areas.

Apply color to areas as follows. **Off White areas** - Buttermilk, highlight lightly with White. Continue using White to mushroom stems and fairy wings. **Pink areas**- Fuschia followed with Light Pink and White. **Blue areas**- Turquoise followed with White to highlight. **Light Green Areas -** Limeburst followed with Brightest Yellow, Buttermilk and then White to highlight. **Yellow areas-** Honey toast, Brightest yellow and highlight with Buttermilk. **Trailers**: Drybrush the A-Line trailer with Shimmering Silver and Buttermilk and white to Retro trailer. Paint colored area of the retro trailers in color of choice. **Fairies**: Flesh – Drybrush with Light Taupe. Drybrush fairy dresses in pastel color of choice. **Before drybrushing, add Buttermilk or White to the color to lighten first. Drybrush with this lightened color, and then highlight with White or Buttermilk added to your brush.**

PAINT: Paint all mushroom caps, red cruiser and trim on teardrop trailer with Christmas Red. Apply white dots to mushrooms with a new pencil eraser or similar round item. Paint window trim, car trim, trailer trim with Shimmering Silver. (refer to flyer) Paint flowers on beetle bug car with Fuschia, Honey Toast, Limeburst, Turquoise, and Orange and drybrush flowers with original color and White added to your brush. Paint fairy eyes with a tip of a toothpick.

SHADE: Shade fairies flesh with Med. Mocha and wings with color of the dress. **FINISH:** Glue screen in windows.

PREPARATIONS: When draining witch hat top, base and shoe tips make sure all cavities drain. Cut out skulls and hats as desired. Place all holes for electrical. Clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: All pieces in Black except the dip bowl and sm. candle holders. Glaze the dip bowl and sm. candle holders with FN-304 Black Velvet following manufactures instructions. Fire all glazed items to cone 06.

DRYBRUSH: Purple areas with 2 coats of the dark purple mix, followed with 2 to 3 coats of Dusty Violet, highlight with White. **Blue areas** with 2 coats of the blue mix, followed with 2 coats of Rich Blue, highlight with White. Drybrush the highlighted White areas again with Rich Blue to achieve the vivid electric bright blue highlight. **Green areas** with 2 coats of Country Sage, followed with 2 coats of Limeburst and brightest Yellow. **NOTE:** When drybrushing the skulls with these colors, the color is drybrushed very lightly. **Orange areas** with Orange Rust, followed with Orange and Brightest Yellow.

PAINT: Insides of shoes, toe and heel of blue shoes with Black. Shoe stripes with Gold, Silver and Black. Apply Gloss Sealer to toe and heel of the blue shoe.

FINISH: Decorate shoes and hats as desired. Glitter used in blue shoes is a 1:1 mix of Recollections extra fine Ebony and Marine.
