Materials Needed

OPAQUE STAINS: Vanilla, White, Black, Christmas Red, Sherwood Green, Black Forest Green, Victorian Green, Marigold Yellow, Shadow Gray, Dark Blond, Night Blue, Electric Blue, Flesh, Deep Brown, Medium Brown, Country Gold and Peach Blush.

TRANSLUCENT STAIN: Glistening Brown.

SPECIALTIES: Gloss Sealer, Gold Leaf and Gold Leaf Adhesive.

MISC: Medium globe lights, plastic star, lg. tree hook-up.

PREPARATION: While greenware is still wet, place holes in the tree using the sm. end of the #2 Clay Magic tool. Place a hole in the top of the tree for the star. Place proper holes in the base for electrical. When the greenware is dry, clean the greenware in the usual manner, replacing any lost fur texture with the TL-9 Texture Tool. Fire to cone 05.

NOTE: The following instructions are how the pieces were finished as pictured. To speed up the process, basecoat the tree base Christmas Red and all the other pieces with Deep Brown and drybrush the colors to the areas as stated. This will eliminate separate basecoats, antiquing and shading.

BASECOAT: With Flesh, all faces and Mrs. Santa's hands. With Vanilla, all hair, beards, fur trim and Mrs. Santa's underskirt and apron trim, elves fur trim, the white areas of the boat and the white areas of the toy soldier. With Christmas Red all Santa suits, Mrs. Santa's dress, tree base, N O E L letters, toy train and the bear's ribbon. The dolls hair with Dark Blond.

ANTIQU: Excluding the tree base, antique these areas with Glistening Brown. Wipe off excess with a soft cloth. You may even take an old drybrush to remove some of the antique from deep crevices.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush all flesh areas with 3 coats of Flesh. Blush all cheeks

lightly with Peach Blush. Drybrush the Vanilla areas with 2 to 3 coats of Vanilla, followed with 2 coats of White. Drybrush the doll's hair with 2 coats of Dark Blond, followed with Vanilla to highlight. Carefully drybrush the red areas with 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Red.

BASECOAT: Very carefully basecoat the tree, wreath, candle hat base, mittens, Mrs. Santa's apron, the letters SANTA and 1 shirt, 1 hat and the legs of 3 different elves. (refer to picture) with Black Forest Green.

DRYBRUSH: These green areas with 2 to 3 coats of Sherwood Green, followed with 2 to 3 coats of Victorian Green. Highlight with Marigold Yellow 1 to 2 light coats to the tips of the branches, and 3 coats to the mittens and the elves green areas. Highlight these same areas with Vanilla added to your brush.

BASECOAT: With a 3:1 mix of Night Blue and Black, basecoat the remainder of the elves clothing, doll's shirt, boats trim and toy soldier's hat and shirt.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush 2 coats of Night Blue, followed with 1 to 2 coats of Electric Blue. Follow with White in your brush to highlight, 1 to 2 light coats.

BASECOAT: The bears on N O E L and toy bear with Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: The bears as follows: 3 coats of Walnut, 2 to 3 coats of Medium Brown, 2 to 3 coats of Country Gold, 2 coats of Dark Blond and highlight with Vanilla. Blush the cheeks with Peach Blush.

BASECOAT: With Black, all of the Santa's boots and belt and the trim on the toys. Basecoat Snowman buddy, snowflakes on tree and wreath with Sky Blue.

DRYBRUSH: All Santa's boots (except Santa with pocket) with Shadow Grey. Rebasecoat soles of boots with Black. Drybrush snowman buddy, snowflakes on tree, wreath, N O E L and S A N T A with 3 to 4 coats of White.

BASECOAT: Snowman buddies nose with Auburn, drybrush with Bright Orange.

PAINT: All eyes. Apply gold leaf or paint gold to Santa's belt buckle and trim on toys. Using gloss sealer, paint onto all boot soles, belt and belt buckle and eyes. Apply 2 to 3 coats of gloss sealer to the entire boots of Santa with pockets, candle hat base and tree base.

FINISH: Glue in lights and star to tree. Hook up electrical with a standard tree light kit.

JOY PENGUINS AND IGLOO LIGHT

Materials Needed

OPAQUE STAINS: Sky Blue, Vanilla, White, Black, Night Blue, Electric Blue, Shadow Gray, Auburn, Bright Orange, Black Forest Green, Sherwood Green, Victorian Green, Burgundy, Peach Blush, Marigold and Christmas Red.

MISC: Electric light hook up or tea light for Igloo.

PREPARATION: While greenware is still damp, cut out igloo windows and door. Place a hole for electrical and cord if hooking up with electrical.

BASECOAT: Igloo and base with Sky Blue, basecoat J O Y penguins with 3:1 mixture of Night Blue and Black.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush letters with 2 coats of Night Blue followed with 1 to 2 coats of Electric Blue, highlight with White added to your brush. Drybrush igloo, base, white areas of penguins and white pom poms with 2 coats of Vanilla followed with 2 to 3 coats of White. Blush penguins cheeks lightly with Peach Blush.

REBASECOAT and DRYBRUSH: Rebasecoat and drybrush each area before going on to the next rebasecoat color. Black areas of penguins with Black, drybrush with Shadow Gray. Red areas with Burgundy, drybrush with Christmas Red then lightly with Bright Orange in your brush. Orange areas with Auburn drybrushed with Bright Orange, highlighted with Marigold. Green areas with Black Forest Green, drybrushed with Sher wood Green, highlight with Victorian Green. Drybrush snowflakes with 2 to 3 coats of White.

FINISH: Hook up with Electrical. Glue elves and toys as desired.

REINDEERS

Materials Needed

OPAQUE STAINS: Deep Brown, Walnut, Auburn, Vanilla, Sherwood Green, Black Forest Green, Victorian Green, Christmas Red, Bright Orange, Marigold, Black and White.

MISC: Gold Leaf, Gold Leaf Adhesive or Water Base Gold, Clear Gloss Sealer. Large Brown pom pom for reindeer with pockets tail. If you are unable to find a brown pom pom, dye a white one with a mixture of Deep Brown and water.

PREPARATION: While greenware is still damp, cut out arm pockets where indicated. Clean reindeer atts. and make sure they fit properly in Santa reindeer's arms. Retexture seam where necessary using the TL-9 texture tool.

BASECOAT: All pieces using Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: All reindeer fur areas and antlers with 2 to 3 coats of Walnut, followed with 1 to 2 coats of Auburn. Using the same brush use Vanilla to highlight tips of antlers, hair, around eyes, nose and insides of ears, middle of forehead and tops of legs. If necessary go over these same areas with Walnut to blend. Using a clean brush, drybrush 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Red to Santa's coat and red nose followed with 1 very light coat of Bright Orange. Again using a fresh drybrush, drybrush 2 to 3 coats of Black Forest Green to all green areas. Follow with Victorian Green, highlight with Marigold added to your brush.

Drybrush fur trim with 2 to 3 coats of Vanilla followed with 2 to 3 coats of White.

PAINT: Reindeer hooves Black. Paint eyes using Electric Blue for the irises.

Apply gold leaf or paint gold to gold areas. Apply 2 coats of gloss sealer to hooves, eyes and gold areas.

FINISH: Glue reindeer to pockets.
