

## ALL THE PUMPKINS and GHOSTS

### Materials Needed

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Persimmon, Orange Peel, Papaya, Peach, Avocado, Medium Green, Lemon Grass, Curry, Dark Yellow, White, Bright Blue, Concord, Walnut, Saddle Brown and Black.

**TRANSLUCENT STAIN:** Tan Sparkle and Pecan Sparkle.

**MISC.:** Desired length of 1” PVC pipe.

**PREPARATION:** After removing cast from mold cut out greenware as desired. Cut out mouths, if desired cut out some teeth. Using Kempers star punch tools cut out stars in pumpkins and ghosts as desired. Cut out proper holes for electrical.

If desired slip attach hands to pumpkins. Cut out proper size holes in hands to hold PVC pipe or flag. Cut out holes in Thumbs Up Pumpkin to hold small flags. Allow to dry, clean greenware in the usual manner and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Color to pieces as follows: **Persimmon** – All orange areas. **Avocado** – All green areas. **Lemon Grass** – All White areas. **Walnut** – To sign posts. **Curry** – “Boo” Signs.

**ANTIQUÉ:** Using 1:1 mix of Tan Sparkle and Pecan Sparkle, antique all painted areas, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Color to areas as follows: **PERSIMMON** – To all orange areas, apply 2 drybrush coats of Persimmon followed with 2 to 3 coats of Orange Peel, highlight using Papaya. Blush cheeks and noses using a mix of Persimmon and Peach. **AVOCADO** – To all green areas apply 2 coats of Avocado followed with 2 coats of Medium Green, highlight using Lemon Grass. **LEMON GRASS** – To all ghosts and teeth apply 2 drybrush coats followed with White added to your brush. For whiter ghosts and teeth apply more coats of White. Blush ghosts cheeks lightly with Peach.

**WALNUT** – To all brown areas apply 2 coats of Walnut, highlight with Saddle Brown. **CURRY** – Apply 2 coats to sign followed with 2 coats of Dark Yellow, highlight adding White to your brush.

**PAINT:** Eyes using Bright Blue for the irises. Paint words on signs using Concord or Persimmon. Paint PVC pipe with Concord.

**FINISH:** Hook up with electrical.

## **FROG WITCH, SPIDERS and CROW**

### **Mold Numbers**

### **Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Avocado, Medium Green, Lemon Grass, Dark Yellow, Concord, Pansy, Curry, Fire Thorn, Persimmon, Orange Peel, Magenta, Bright Red, Bright Blue, Black, Ivory and White.

**TRANSLUCENT STAIN:** Pecan Sparkle and Tan Sparkle.

**PREPARATION:** After removing cast from the mold, cut out areas as desired for lighting. Use Kemper star cut out tools to cut out stars. Allow to dry, clean greenware in the usual manner and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Color to areas as follows: **AVOCADO** – to all green areas.

**FIRE THORN** – To red spider legs and Happy Harvest sign post. **IVORY** – To Oops thought bubbles and book pages. **DARK YELLOW** – To straw in crows hat. **BUTTERSCOTCH** – To crows hat. **CURRY** – To crows sign, beak and feet, and spiders eyes and nose. **LEMON GRASS** – To spider's teeth.

**ANTIQUÉ:** Using a 1:1 mix of Tan Sparkle and Pecan Sparkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**NOTE:** Follow the pumpkin instructions for the pumpkin area of the Crow on Pumpkin.

**DRYBRUSH:** Green areas of frog with 2 coats of Avocado followed with 2 coats of Medium Green, highlight with Dark Yellow. Paint inside of star cut outs with Lemon Grass. Drybrush green spider legs with 2 coats of Avocado, followed with 2 coats of Medium Green, highlight with Lemon Grass. Apply yellow stripes on legs with Dark Yellow followed with White added to your brush. Drybrush spider eyes with 2 coats of Curry followed with Dark Yellow, highlight with White added to your brush. Drybrush spider's teeth with 2 coats of Lemon Grass followed with White added to your brush. Drybrush Oops bubbles and book pages with 3 coats of Ivory followed with 2 to 3 coats of White. Drybrush band on witch hat with Persimmon followed with Orange Peel. Drybrush crow's beak and feet with 2 coats of Curry followed with 2 coats of Ivory added to your brush. Drybrush Curry to Crow's sign, highlight with Dark Yellow. Drybrush straw with Dark Yellow followed with White added to your brush. Drybrush Fire Thorn to red spider legs follow with Bright Red. Drybrush Persimmon to tips

of spiders legs and create stripes on legs, highlight with Orange Peel. Using Dark Yellow apply more stripes to spiders legs. Highlight yellow stripes with White added to your brush. Drybrush black stripes to green spider legs.

**BASECOAT:** Spider heads avoiding eyes and teeth, crows body and eye area, frog's hat and book cover neatly with Black.

**DRYBRUSH:** All black areas with 1 to 2 coats of Concord. If desired highlight with Pansy.

**PAINT:** Hat buckle and around "Oops" thought bubbles with Black. Use rub on metallic for buckle or drybrush using a metallic paint. Paint eyes using Bright Blue for the irises.

**FINISH:** Hook up electrical.

## **TROLL**

### **Mold Number**

**TL 1020 Twixter Troll 12"W \$52.00**

### **Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Chocolate Fudge, Concord, Pansy, Purple, Avocado, Medium Green, Dark Yellow, Black, White and Bright Blue.

**BASECOAT:** Basecoat troll using Chocolate Fudge.

**DRYBRUSH:** Green areas with 2 to 3 coats of Avocado followed with 2 coats of Medium Green, highlight with Dark Yellow. Drybrush teeth and nails with Dark Yellow followed with White added to your brush. Drybrush hair with Concord followed with Pansy and then Purple, highlight lightly with White added to your brush.

**PAINT:** Eyes using Bright Blue for the irises.
