MAYCO Glazes: PB001 Clear Brushing

EZ STROKES: 013 White, 027 Blue Turquoise, and 012 Cobalt Jet Black.

UNDERGLAZE: UG051 White, UG046 Bright Yellow, UG203 Squash Yellow, UG223 Apricot, UG231 Lime Green, UG022 Spring Green, UG220 Sage and UG030 Sand.

SPECIALITY PRODUCTS: AC302 Wax Resist, AC501 Gloss Sealer and AC523 Snow.

FOUNDATIONS: FN001 White and FN002 Yellow

STROKES AND COATS: SC016 Cotton tail, SC097 Cant-elope, SC025 Cracker Jack, SC005 Tiger Tail, SC083 Tip Taupe, SC023 Jack o Lantern, SC075 Orange-A-Peel SC042 Butter Me UP, SC6 Sunkissed SC045 My Blue Heaven, SC011 Blue Yonder, SC100 Makin me Blush, and 015 Tuxedo.

MISC: 7mm clear round globe lights.

DUNCAN BISQUE STAIN: BLUE MIX: OS432 Ivory, 2:1:1 OS431 White, OS456 Baby Blue, and OS469 Light Turquoise. Assorted other colors.

WASH: Med. Mocha Wash 1:3:3 OS436 Gold, OS489 Saddle Brown and water.

METALLIC PAINT: Modern Masters Gold Rush.

BRUSHES: AB-834 ¾" Basecoat, RB-138 3/8" Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, 10/0 Mini Liner, CB 110, Script Liner CB 106, #4 Soft Fan CB-604, UB and round AB Drybrushes.

GOOSES, BUNNIES, BOOTS AND OWL

MOLD NUMBERS

4526 Standing Goose Body 15"T x 10.25"W

4527 Standing Goose Head Straight

4528 Standing Goose Head Turned

4529 Desk Goose 7"T x 5.5"L

704 Garden Bunny Standing 13.5"T x 8.75"W

705 Ears for Standing Bunny

706 Garden Bunny Sitting 11"T x 11"L

CD859 Sm. Rain Boots Planter 5"T x 6.25"L x 4.75"W

CD1331 Owl Planter 6.5"T x 6.5"W

PREPARATION: Clean Greenware.

APPLY UNDERGLAZE: Apply 3 coats UG051 China White to all White areas except flowers on boots. Apply 3 coats UG046 Bright to Yellow area of boots. Apply 3 coats UG223 Apricot to duck's Feet and beaks. When dry fire to cone 04.

APPLY FOUNDATIONS: With slightly watered down Tip taupe, consistency of heavy cream apply to all areas. Wipe off with a damp sponge leaving the paint in the crevices. Apply FN002 Yellow to inside of boots and owl planter. Apply 1 coat of SC100 Makin Me Blush to the inside areas of bunnies' ears.

EZ-STROKES: Paint the eyes of the **goose and bunnies** using a mix of Bright Blue and White for the irises. Paint the pupils and line the eyes with Cobalt Jet Black. Neatly apply 2 light coats of Diamond Clear Glaze. When completely dry carefully apply 2 thin or one heavy coat of wax resist to eyes over the clear glaze.

FINISH OWL AND BOOTS: Owl eyes -Using a medium soft fan brush apply SC045 Blue Yonder and SC011 My Blue Heaven to the owl's eyes; one color each on one half of the brush. With the Blue Yonder half of the brush nearest to the pupil, apply around the eye, blending the two colors with the light blue on the outside of the eye. Paint pupils with Tuxedo. Apply 2 coats of a mix of

SC042 Butter me Up and SC6 Sunkissed to beaks and feet. Dot Pupil with Cotton Tail. Make a template for the flowers and transfer the pattern to the boots as shown. Paint the flowers with 3 coats of Cotton Tail and the flower centers with 3 coats of Sunkissed.

GLAZING GEESE, BOOTS AND BUNNIES'- Apply 1 even coat each of SC075 Orange-A-Peel first then SC023 Jack O'Lantern to Beaks and feet of geese. Apply 1 thinned coat of FN001 White to all white areas avoiding the beaks and feet. Apply 1 coat of Milk Glass to all areas except beaks and feet. Apply 1 coat of Clear Brushing to all areas, including beaks and feet. Gently wipe off any excess paint left on wax resist area of eyes with a small wet dry brush. Fire to cone 06.

GLAZING OWL and BOOTS: Apply 2 coats of clear glaze to the outside of each item. Fire to cone 06.

BASES USED

2361 Plain Snow Base 8.25"L

2365 Long Snow Base 11.5"L

4012 15" Base 15" x 10"

PREPARATION: Cut out stars and words. Place holes for pin lights if desired and any holes for electrical sockets and cords. Clean seams fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT- All snow areas with the **BLUE MIX**. All other areas with Ivory.

WASH: Snow areas with the Med. Mocha wash. Wipe off with a soft cloth before the wash dries. The Ivory areas with a damp brush and Gold, do not wipe off.

DRYBRUSH: Snow areas with 1 coat of the blue mix, continue with 2 coats of Ivory in your brush. Follow with 3 to 4 coats of White. All other areas with 3 coats of Ivory and 1 coat of White. Blush cheeks with blush color of choice.

PAINT: Using colors of choice, paint color on clothing areas in watercolor fashion.

With paint on a palette and water, thin paint with a wet angled shader slightly thinning the color. Apply color to your piece. If the color is too weak looking add more paint. Apply to piece as neatly as possible without over brushing.

FINISH: Decorate using glitter, snow, jewels etc.

CORN PUMPKINS & TURTLE SCRUBBY

MOLD NUMBERS

4524 Tall Corn Pumpkin 8.25"T x 5.75"W 14 \$64

4525 Short Corn Pumpkin 6"T 5.25"W 13 \$64

4530 Turtle Scrubby 4"T x 6"L x 3.5"W 10 \$59

PREPARATION: Clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

UNDERGLAZE: 3 coats of each as follows. Pumpkin kernels with a 1:1 mix of Bright Yellow and Squash, stems with sand and leaves with Spring Green, Lime Green and China White. Using brush of choice apply 1 coat of Spring Green to outer leaf areas followed with Lime green to center of leaf and China White to the top of leaf blending with the Lime Green. Go around the pumpkin 3 times without completely drying. This seems to blend the paint. You may need to wipe off excess paint from your brush from time to time. The **TURTLE SCRUBBY** with Sage. Fire to 04.

GLAZE: With a 2:1 mix of Tiger Tail and Cracker Jack, thinned slightly, apply over entire pumpkin. Wipe off with a damp sponge leaving the paint in the crevices. Apply 2 thin coats of Milk Glass and 1 coat of clear glaze to the kernels. Apply 2 coats of clear glaze to the leaves and stems.

TURTLE SCRUBBY: Apply 1:1 mix of Tiger Tail and Cracker Jack to turtle, slightly thinned. Wipe off with a damp sponge, leaving the paint in the crevices. Paint turtle's eyes as show using a mix of My Blue Heaven and Blue Yonder for the iris. Apply one coat of Cotton Tail to toenails, and 2 dots of Lime Light to bumps on turtle's body. Using a medium fan brush that is damp with a little excess water in it, with Tiger Tail on a palette, slide one side your soft fan into the Tiger Tail. Using the paint side of the brush, apply around the bottom edge of the turtle shell, apply 3 coats this way. The density of the color will fade as it is near the top of the turtle shell. Once dry apply one coat of Java Bean to the very bottom of the turtle shell with an angled shader. Line mouth, around toes, legs and where you would like a little more contrast; with thinned Java Bean. Glaze inside of turtle with Cracker Jack or color of choice, on outside of the turtle with 2 coats of clear glaze. Fire to cone 06.
