PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, cut out windows, stars, bats, moons, holes and names or phrases as desired, place all holes for electrical. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Ghost head stacks, the white and orange areas of ghosts with Orange Peel. Basecoat bases with Buttermilk.

ANTIQUE: All pieces with 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: White areas of ghosts with 2 coats of Orange Peel, 3 to 4 coats of Buttermilk and 3 to 4 coats of White. Blush cheeks with a small amount of Brick Red and Orange added to your brush. Drybrush bases with 2 coats of Buttermilk followed with 1 to 2 coats of White. Drybrush center of orange sky behind house with Brick Red. Continue this area and the sky of the fence scene ghost with Orange and then Orange Peel. Blend the white of the ghost and the orange of the sky and around the full moon with Brightest Yellow, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush.

BASECOAT: Ghosts hats and scenes as shown carefully and neatly with Flat Black.

DRYBRUSH: Areas with colors as follows: **Green areas** – Accent Green, Forest Green and Limeburst, lightly highlight with Brightest Yellow added to your brush. **Orange areas** – Brick Red, Orange and Orange Peel. Highlight with Brightest Yellow and then Buttermilk added to your brush. **Purple areas** – Navy, Deep Purple, Dusty Violet and Hushed Violet. **Blue Areas** – Navy, Dark Blue and Medium Blue. **Vultures beak** – Golden Ochre, Honey Toast and White. **PAINT:** Paint eyes with Flat Black.

SHADE: Shade ghost if desired using Brick Red.

FINISH: Using desired cotton material, rip about a 2 ½" strip for tying a bow around necks. Shred end of bow by ripping cloth as desired.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, cut slits in cornstalk for lighting as shown or desired and slip attach leaves and acorns as desired. Place all holes for electrical. Allow to dry and clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Cornstalk with Medium Mocha.

ANTIQUE: All pieces with 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Cornstalk with 2 to 3 coats each of Medium Mocha, Golden Ochre and Buttermilk.

BASECOAT: Leaves and Acorns with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Red leaves with Old World Santa followed with Antique Red, Red, Brick Red, Orange Peel and Orange. Drybrush acorns with Chocolate, Medium Mocha. Highlight nut with Orange Rust and cap with Golden Ochre. **SHADE:** If desired shade cornstalk with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: With 1 to 2 coats of Navy followed with Deep Purple. Pinker bats and spider are drybrushed with Royal Fuchsia added to your brush. Highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush.

PAINT: Eyes as shown or desired.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, cut out eyes, nose and pourgate as shown. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

GLAZE: Glaze inside of candle cup and fire to cone 06.

BASECOAT: Color to area as follows: Orange – Orange areas. Accent Green – green areas. Orange Peel– Ghost parts.

ANTIQUE: All pieces with 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Orange areas with Orange, Orange Peel, Honey Toast and Buttermilk, blush cheeks using a small amount of Brick Red and Orange. **Ghost** with Orange Peel followed with Buttermilk and then White. Green areas – Accent Green followed with Forest Green and Limeburst.

PAINT: Cat witch's hat Flat Black. Drybrush hat with Navy, Deep Purple and Dusty Violet. Paint eyes as desired.

BASECOAT: Bisque with Chocolate Fudge.

ANTIQUE: All pieces with 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: With Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate, Medium Mocha and Buttermilk. **PAINT:** Eyes and nose.

GREEN MAN WELCOME PLANTER MOLD NUMBER 3172 Green Man Welcome Planter 14.5"T x 11"W \$118.00

PREPARATION: Pour cast on the heavy side. If desired for a bird feeder, after removing cast from the mold, press the clay in bottom hand down to the bottom of the planter, if necessary fill in any cracks or holes from the inside using discarded pourgate clay. Place holes for drainage if desired. Carefully glaze inside of planter with desired glaze, fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Brown areas with Chocolate followed with Medium Mocha, Golden Ochre, Light Umber and Buttermilk. Drybrush the leaves with 2 to 3 coats of Accent Green, continue with Forest Green, Country Sage and Limeburst. With a fresh brush tip the facial leaves and ears lightly with Country Sage and Limeburst.

PAINT: Welcome letters with Flat Black. Drybrush letters with Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate and highlight with Medium Mocha.

COPPER WASH: If desired, apply a copper wash. Mix 2:1 water and Copper, using a fan brush and over a sink apply over planter. Working quickly using a fan brush add water over the copper wash for an even flow. Set aside and allow to dry undisturbed.

DRYBRUSH: To tone down the copper, drybrush leaves lightly with the previous greens.

SHADE: Shade nose and mouth using Flat Black.
