MAYCO Glazes: PB001 Clear Brushing

EZ STROKES: 013 White, 027 Blue Turquoise, and 012 Cobalt Jet Black.

UNDERGLAZE: UG046 Bright Yellow, UG203 Squash Yellow, UG58 Harvest Gold, UG19 Electra Blue, UG82 Tucson Turquoise and UG31 Chocolate

STROKES AND COATS: SC5 Tiger Tail, SC25 Cracker Jack, SC14 Java Bean.

DUNCAN BISQUE STAIN: OS459 Bright Blue, OS434 Lemon Peel, OS438 Orange Peel, OS431 White, OS476 Black, OS484 Persimmon, OS435 Dark Yellow, OS449 Bright Red, OS483 Medium Green, OS503 Fire Thorn, OS588 Golden Ochre, OS432 Ivory, OS 460 Navy, OS489 Saddle Brown, OS436 Gold, OS493 Sandalwood, UM956 Silver and OS472 Walnut.

COLOR MIXES: **Med. Blue mix-** 1:5 OS431 White and OS460 Navy, **Med. Mocha mix-1:2** Saddle Brown and OS436 Gold. **Dark Blue mix-** with Bright Blue, add Black slowly for a dark blue.

WASH: **Med. Mocha Wash** 1:2:3-Saddle Brown, Gold and water.

BRUSHES: AB-834 ¾" Basecoat, RB-138 3/8" Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, 10/0 Mini Liner, CB 110, Script Liner CB 106, #4 Soft Fan CB-604, UB and round AB Drybrushes.

SUNFLOWER BOWLS

MOLD NUMBERS

CD044 Sunflower Bowl 2.75"H x 12"Dia.

CD045 Sm. Sunflower Bowl 1.75"H x 7.24" Dia.

PREPARATION: Clean Greenware.

APPLY UNDERGLAZE: **2:1 Mix of Bright Yellow and Squash** and apply three coats to the sunflower petals, apply a coat of Bright Yellow to the tips and about ½ way down each flower petal. Apply 3 coats of Harvest Gold to the ring area around the seeds. Apply 3 coats of Chocolate to the sunflower seeds. We painted the side of the bowls with a blue underglaze, we used Tucson Turquoise on the small bowl and Electra Blue on the large bowl, three coats. When dry fire to cone 04.

Stroke & Coat: **Mix 2:1 Tiger Tail and Cracker Jack** and apply one slightly thinned coat to the flower areas avoiding the blue areas. Wipe off excess, leaving the color in the crevices. Using Java Bean, apply one slightly thinned coat to the seeds, wipe away excess.

GLAZE: Using PB001 Clear Brushing, apply 2 coats and fire to cone 06.

GNOMES, CROWS, SCARECROWS AND PUMPKINS WITH SUNFLOWERS

MOLD NUMBERS

3680 14.25" Scare "Crow" Gather Here 5.75"W

3681 12" Scare "Crow" Be Grateful, Be Thankful 5.5"W

3682 9" Scare "Crow" Give Thanks 4.5"W

4050 15.5 Garth the Nordic Gnome 8.5"W

4057 Garth Plain Sign att. 6.5"T

4270 Sunflower Gnome for Pickup 5.5"T x 5.5"W

4271 Sven Gnome w/Sunflowers 12"T x 10"W

4272 Sunflower Att. for Garth 9.75"T x 5"W

4275 Gnome with Sunflower Stack 10.5"T x 4.75"W

PREPARATION: While greenware is damp, slip attach hand and sign attachments to Garth. Clean seams, when dry fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT- **White areas-**Ivory, **flesh areas-** Light Taupe, **Blue areas-**dark blue mix, **Yellow areas-** Gold, **Light Blue areas-** Med. Blue mix, **Orange areas-** Persimmon, **Green areas-** Limeburst, **Red areas-** Fire Thorn. **The signs with Sandalwood.**

WASH: Apply the **Med. Mocha wash** to all areas and wipe away quickly before it dries.

DRYBRUSH: **White areas** with 1 to 2 coats of Ivory and continue with White to brighten. **Flesh areas** with 2 coats of Light Taupe, **blush noses** with blush of choice. **Yellow areas** with 2 coats of Gold, followed with 2 to 3 coats of Dark Yellow, highlighted with White. **Green areas** with 2 coats of Limeburst followed with 2 to 3 light coats of Dark Yellow. Highlight with Ivory to lighten. **Darker Blue areas** with 1 to 2 coats of the Dark Blue mix, followed with 2 to 3 coats of the Med. Blue mix. Slowly add white to your brush and highlight, concentrating more to the center of areas. The **Light Blue areas** (scarecrow hats and shirts) with 1 coat of the Med. Blue mix, followed with white added to your brush and lighten, this will take several coats. **The sign** with 2 coats of Sandalwood followed with Ivory in your brush to lighten, concentrating the Ivory to the center of the sign with last couple of coats. **Red areas** with 1 coat of Fire Thorn, followed with Bright Red added to your brush to brighten, 3 coats. Highlight with a couple coats of Persimmon. **Orange pumpkins** with 1 coat of Persimmon followed with a couple coats of Dark Yellow to brighten. Highlight with Ivory.

BASECOAT: Light brown Shoes with Med. Mocha mix, Sunflower centers with Black and the dark brown areas with Walnut.

DRYBRUSH: **Shoes** with the Med. Mocha mix and gold in your brush, drybrush shoes with 3 coats and highlight with Ivory. **Flower centers** with 2 to 3 coats each of Walnut, Chocolate, Med. Mocha mix, Golden Ocher and highlight with Ivory. Start at center top, fading the color towards the bottom. Do this with each color. The dark brown areas with 2 coats each Saddle Brown, Med. Mocha and Golden Ochre to highlight.

WATERCOLOR: Thin Black with a little water to a thin cream consistency. Using a damp angled shader, stripe the hats. The Yellow should show through. When dry, drybrush with the Med. Mocha mix. You may have to do a little more Black shading, giving a mottled look.

SHADE: **With the Med. Mocha mix**, shade all yellow areas, green areas, signs and beards and flesh if needed. **With the Dark Blue mix** shade all the lighter blue areas.

PUMPKINS

MOLD NUMBERS

2353 Happy Pumpkin Light Top 10.25"T x 9"W

2354 Happy Pumpkin Light Base

CD022 Pumpkin w/Sunflowers Topper 6"L x 4.5"H

CD025 Sm. Knitted Pumpkin 4.5"W x 5"T

CD026 Med. Fluted Pumpkin 6"T x 5"W

CD027 Lg. Beaded Pumpkin 8"T x 5"W

CD028 Stack O'Lantern 9.25"W x 17.75"T x 4.75"D

PREPARATION: While greenware is still damp, cut out pumpkins and place all holes for electrical.

Clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: **Orange areas-** Persimmon, **Green areas-**Med. Green, **Yellow areas-**Gold

WASH: Apply the Med. Mocha wash and wipe away quickly before the wash dries.

DRYBRUSH: **Orange areas** with 2 coats of Persimmon, followed by 2 to 3 coats of Dark Yellow. Highlight with Ivory. **Green areas** with 2 coats Med. Green, followed with 2 to 3 coats of Dark Yellow. Highlight with Ivory. **Paint stems** with Walnut and drybrush with Saddle Brown, Med. Mocha mix and Golden Ocher. Decorate as desired.

PICKUP TRUCKS

MOLD NUMBERS

4255 55 Pickup 4.5"T x 9.5"L

CD1508 Vintage Truck Container Set 5.75"T x 6.5"W x 13.5"L

PREPARATION: Cutout the truck beds, make sure the lid fits the bed. Clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: **The trucks** with Bright Blue. **White areas** with Ivory.

WASH: Apply the Med. Mocha wash and wipe off before the wash dries.

DRYBRUSH: 1 coat of Bright Blue, followed with White in your brush to slowly lighten. This will take several light coats. Drybrush the Ivory areas with White.

PAINT: All black areas with Black. Drybrush areas with Silver.

HANDMADE LEAVES AND STARS

Using fresh damp waste clay from pour gates or cut outs or pour a large flat base, cut leaves and stars using a pattern. Either place a hole or attach a high fire ornament wire to the top center of the leaves and in the "V" of the star. Sponge edges, allow to dry and fire to cone 04. Paint as desired using glazes or acrylics and attach to pumpkins as desired using wrapped wire.
