#### Materials Needed

**UNDERGLAZES:** Cottage Brown, Sandalwood, Harvest Gold, Chocolate, China White, Jet Black, Myrtle Green and Jade.

**BISQUE UNDERGLAZE:** Down To Earth and Wine About It.

GLAZE: Yadro

**OVERGLAZE:** Hanovia Gold

**PREPARATION:** Clean greenware in the usual manner, fire to cone 05. **NOTE:** If desired apply underglaze to cleaned greenware. I prefer to underglaze on bisque to minimize chance of breakage. Because I apply underglaze to bisque, it is necessary to apply 4 coats of the underglaze to achieve solid coverage.

**UNDERGLAZE:** Apply 4 coats of underglaze color to areas as follows: Cottage Brown to all flesh areas. China White to Summer's hat band, waist tie, purse and dress trim. Sandalwood to Summer's hat and Springs shirt, blazer, earrings and top area of hat. Chocolate to Summer's dress, scarf and shoes. Harvest Gold to Autumn's Blazer. Apply this mix 2:1 of Jade and Myrtle to ivy and grass area of Summer. Apply this mix 3:1 Cottage Brown and Jet Black to all black areas. Apply Sandalwood, Chocolate, and the black mix to hat band and waist tie of Summer as shown, if desired. Fire to cone O5.

**BISQUE UNDERGLAZE:** Apply Down to Earth to eyes and Wine About It to the lips. When dry apply 3 even coats of Yadro. Fire to cone 06.

**OVERGLAZE:** Apply Hanovia Gold to all areas desired gold, fire to cone 018.

#### Materials Needed

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Deep Brown, Walnut, Burgundy, Night Blue, Sky Blue, Medium Brown, Country Gold, Auburn, Autumn Rust, Dark Forest Green, Sherwood Green, Marigold Yellow, Vanilla, French Vanilla, Hot Pink, Victorian Green, Christmas Red, Confederate Gray, Dark Blonde, Water Base Silver, Water Base Gold. Black and White.

SPECIALITIES: Gloss Sealer.

**BASECOAT:** All pieces with Deep Brown.

**DRYBRUSH:** All flesh areas, bases, girls hats and white and Country Gold areas with 2 to 3 coats of Walnut. Lightly blush cheeks and lips with Burgundy added to your brush. Continue Country Gold and white areas as follows: 1 to 2 coats of Medium Brown followed with 2 to 3 coats of Country Gold. Highlight hats and school boy's shirt lightly with Vanilla added to your brush. Continue white areas with 2 coats of French Vanilla followed with 2 to 3 coats of Vanilla. If desired brighten up lightly with White.

# NOTE: Use your own judgment if an area needs to be rebascoated with Deep Brown before drybrushing the next color.

Drybrush all other color to areas as follows: Hot Pink to standing girl with hats dress and baby dolls dress and hat with 2 to 3 coats. Adding Dark Blond and then Vanilla to the mix lighten these same areas. Highlight with Vanilla. Drybrush blue areas with Night Blue, 2 to 3 coats. Follow with Sky Blue added to your brush, drybrushing very lightly on the darker blue areas and heavier on the lighter blue areas. Drybrush yellow areas with 3 to 4 coats of Marigold followed with Vanilla in your brush to lighten. The more Vanilla added to your brush the lighter the yellow will become. Drybrush green areas with 2 to 3 coats of Dark Forest Green followed with a highlight coat of Sherwood Green added to your brush.. Continue the flower's leaves with 2 coats of Victorian Green. Drybrush the red areas with 2 to 3 coats of Burgundy, followed with 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Red. Drybrush black areas with 2 coats of Black, highlight with Confederate Gray added to your brush to the bowler hats. Fireman's shirt, coat trim and shirt, policeman's accessories and CD player. Drybrush 2 coats of Auburn to the basketball followed with 2 to 3 coats of Autumn Rust. Drvbrush policeman's badges and belt buckle with Water Base Gold. Drybrush axe blade with Water Base Silver. Drybrush dogs both with Walnut continue shepherd puppy with Auburn followed with Medium Brown. Highlight chest and eye area with Vanilla. Drybrush snout, tips of ears and other black areas with Black. Continue Dalmatian puppy with 3 to 4 coats of Vanilla then highlight with White. PAINT: Paint all eves using Walnut for the irises. Apply Gloss Sealer to all the girl's shoes and policeman's shoes and hat brim. Paint the dog tags and disc on CD player with Water Base Silver. Paint all other trim on pieces as desired. Paint spots on Dalmatian with Black.
